Courses of French for academic purposes



This course is only for B1 level students.

Its goal is to give all the necessary skills to better plan your studies ahead in a French University, and more specifically at the University of Perpignan.

This program is about

- **Improving French language.**
- The **linguistic characteristics of the academic discipline** chosen by the student.
- The **Methodological techniques** and the French university culture.

Professors who participate in this training are French professors, as well as professors from various faculties of the University of Perpignan for each subject's own linguistic characteristics.

Course Organization

Duration: 2 semesters, which represents 440 course hours, divided in 22 weeks, from Monday to Friday.

You will have assessments throughout the year, so **attending class is compulsory.**

Since we are a University, we have to respect school breaks.

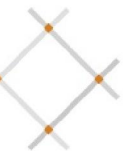
In France, we usually get:

- ▶ 2 weeks off for "Christmas holidays",

This student area is home to over 80 student associations and organizes more than **15 free artistic workshops**.

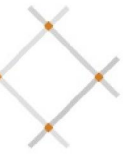
You will be given a **Culture Pass** that will enable you to get discounts on cultural events organized by the city and the region.



► Physical and sporting Activities service

For a subscription of 20€, you will get **unlimited access to the University exercise room and to more than 30 sporting activities** proposed each week.





Moreover, in order for you to discover new sports, the University organizes orientation days dedicated to new sports: scuba diving, sailing, skiing, etc.

► Student benefits



By learning French at the CUEF, you will automatically get a student card: Valid in all of Europe, **this card gets you discounts** in all museums, movie theaters, tourist attractions, and some restaurants.



WHEN?

2 sessions are offered: ► Fall-Spring Session (from September to May)
► Winter-Summer Session (from January to August)

How much?

All the proposed services cost **€ 3,020** (for reference: € 137 per week).

Payment is processed in 2 parts:

- € 250 when booking the course
- the balance when the course begins.

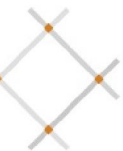
The booking is to be paid online using secured payment on our website.

You can pay the full amount by credit card through the website or on the spot, by check or bank transfer.

Be careful! You will be required by French law to pay Social Security contributions, which cost € 215, to maintain your health.

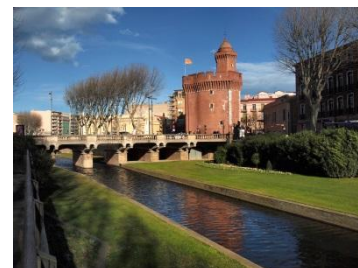

Perpignan

Perpignan is a medium-sized city, with 120,000 inhabitants, located a few kilometers from the Spanish border.

Nestled between the snowy Pyrenees Mountains and the Mediterranean Sea, Perpignan is at the center of the Toulouse-Barcelona-Montpellier triangle, one of the most touristic areas in Europe.

Its sunny climate, its cultural inheritance, its Catalan identity and exceptional sites surrounding it, such as the *Cité de Carcassonne*, the *Canal du Midi* and picturesque villages such as *Collioure*, make Perpignan a privileged destination to combine sightseeing and French learning.
